Who does Breaking Barriers Support?

- Refugees to find meaningful employment nationwide.
- Eligibility for each programme does differ but the below criteria must apply.

Our programmes support:

- **Age:** Individuals aged 18 and older.
- **Language ability** to engage independently with advisors, volunteers, and group sessions. (B1 for Language and Reaccreditation Team)

We support those with the following statuses from the UK or another EU country:

Immigration Status:

- Refugee status
- Discretionary leave to remain
- Humanitarian protection
- Residency in the UK or another EU country (previously met criteria)
- In the UK on a family reunion visa with a person meeting the criteria
- Asylum seekers with the right to work
- Survivors of human trafficking with the right to work
- Homes for Ukraine Scheme
- Individuals from Hong Kong with British National (Overseas) visas

Support Provided:

One to one employment support delivered by advisers and trained volunteers/mentors.

Language and Re-accreditation Programmes

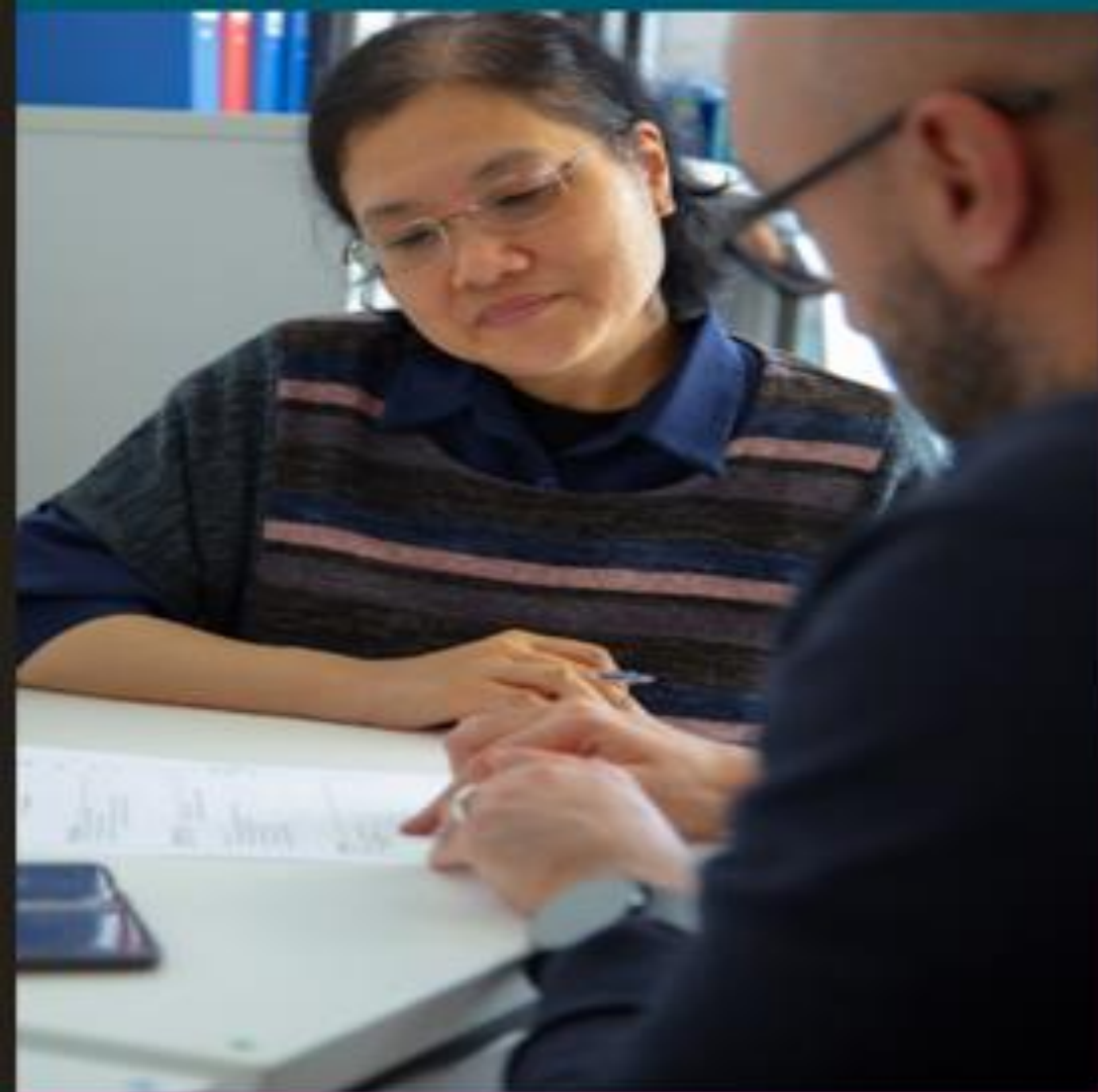
We support clients who are either:

Reaccreditation Programme

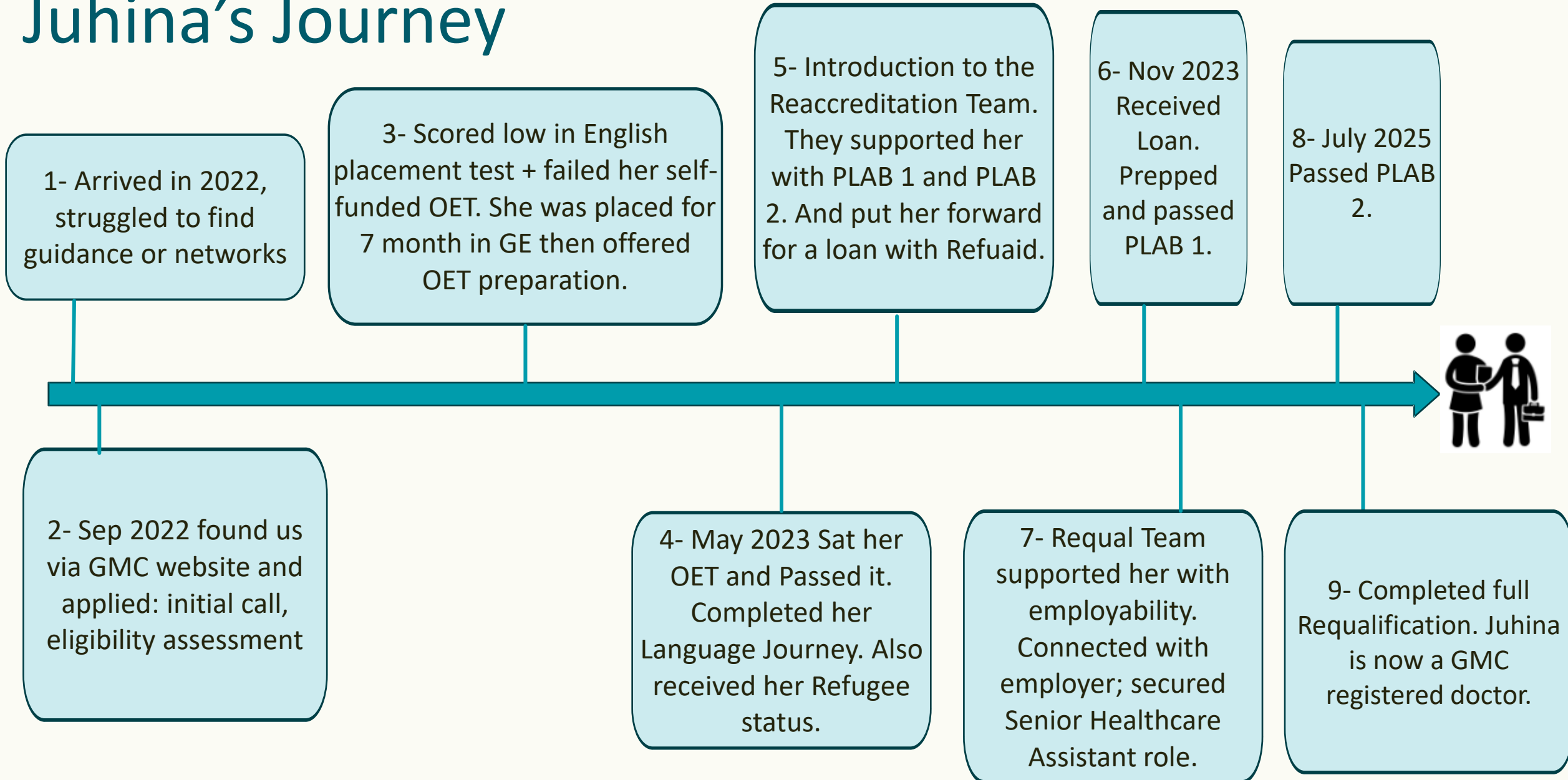
- Advice and guidance on reaccreditation pathways
